Key Technical Contributions

- Creative Commons: Developed frameworks for sharing creative works.
- Reddit: Co-founded one of the internet's most popular news sites.
- Markdown: Contributed to the creation of this digital publishing format.
- web.py: Created a lightweight web framework.

Activism and Advocacy

- Watchdog.net: Created to promote political transparency.
- Demand Progress: Fought against internet censorship, including SOPA/PIPA.
- Played a central role in mobilizing millions to protect internet freedom.

Open Access Movement

- Guerilla Open Access Manifesto: Called for open access to research.
- Downloaded millions of JSTOR articles to make knowledge public.
- Faced severe legal consequences, highlighting restrictive academic publishing.

Legacy

- Open Access Impact: Inspired the movement for accessible academic research.
- Digital Rights Activism: Continues to influence digital rights advocates.
- Posthumous Recognition: Inducted into the Internet Hall of Fame in 2013.
